Getting Answers to Critical Problems

Sr. Emmanuel, (author of excellent books) writes that many parents come to her at Medjugorje with critical needs for young adult children. They complain to her that they have prayed for a long time but God does not seem to answer. She tells them to fast because prayer becomes very powerful when joined to fasting. Most say, "but I love food". Her response, "Which do you love most, food or your children?"

This is excellent advice So many parents pray for their young adult children to return to mass, or to break a relationship or to be freed from addiction. Often with seemingly no success. The secret is to add a little fasting to our prayers.

Please do not be overwhelmed by fasting. Take the first step (no matter how small) and do not turn back.
